The Project Serve Mission Team from Riverside Community Church has been going to the Navajo Indian Reservation for 17 years bring help, hope and love to the Navajo people. Besides doing physical building projects on the mission trip, one of the highlights of the trip is that we host a Kids Fun Fair with games, food and activities with between 75-100 kids attending. The Aldersgate Toy Ministry has been a huge blessing by donating cars and trucks for the last several years to Project Serve for us to give out to the Navajo children. We love seeing the smiles on the Navajo children when they receive a prize, and the biggest smiles come when they receive a hand-made wooden car or truck made by the people at Aldersgate. 
